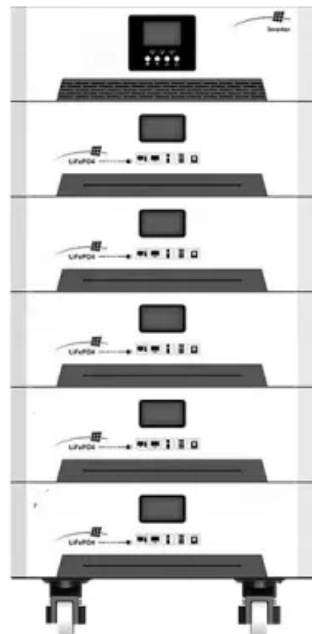

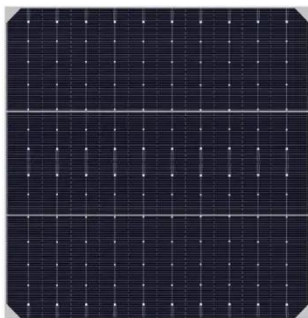
## GSM GPRS EDGE Base Station Troubleshooting Guide

## Can't Connect Base Station to Wi-Fi During Setup

To connect the Base Station to Wi-Fi or install the SimpliSafe® cameras, you'll need to temporarily change this to WPA2. Once these devices are set up, you can change this setting back to WPA3.

## Solved: Base Station Is Not Detected

Until the Internet LED is green, it won't work. Since it's off, that means that it's one of the following - bad base port, bad router port or bad Ethernet cable.



## Contact Sensor won't connect to Base Station : r/Ring

Now I tried adding another contact sensor, but it does not connect to the base station. The lights on the sensor flash three times green, indicating that it is still searching.

## How to troubleshoot the LEDs on the base station

If the base station is not communicating with the WLAN, check the three LEDs on the top panel. They report network and modem activity, operational status, and radio activity.
