Community solar – also called shared solar or solar gardens – means local solar panels that many people in the community share. Unlike rooftop solar that serves just one home, these solar farms are usually built on open land and can power hundreds or thousands of homes. This bulletin focuses on potential cooperative and community opportunities in solar energy development and use. About 1800 MW came online in 2021 alone. What is Community Solar?

Community solar. In a community shared solar (CSS) program, a large solar photovoltaic (PV) system provides power or financial benefit to multiple community members.

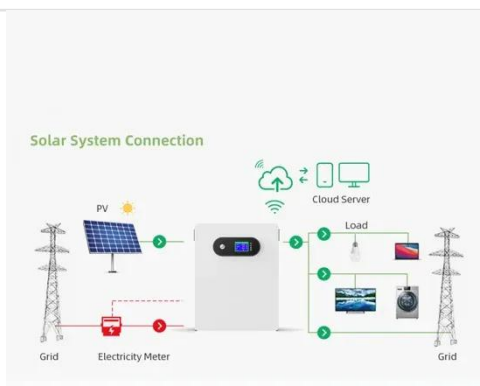

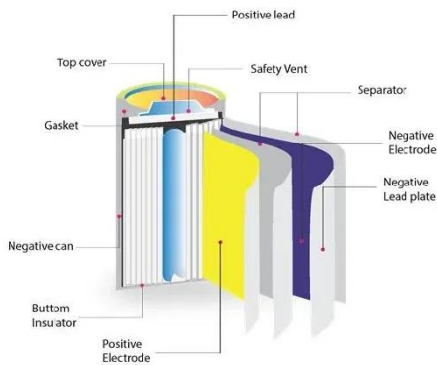
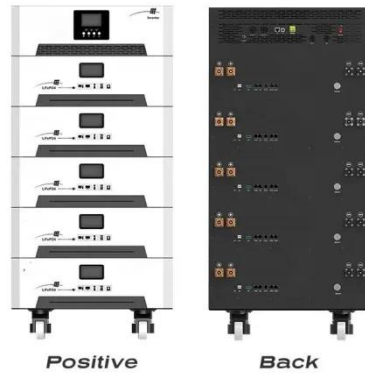
