

Dublin electricity consumption

Overview

Total metered electricity consumption in 2023 was 30,600 GWh (gigawatt hours) in 2023, an increase of 2.3% compared with 2022 (See Table 1). The amount of electricity consumed by large energy users increased by 1.5% in 2023. Residential electricity consumption rose across every county in Ireland in 2023, with Dublin's postal districts accounting for the largest share, according to new figures from the Central Statistics Office (CSO). Dublin areas consumed the most power at 19 percent of all residential usage.

Key Findings Metered Electricity Consumption 2024

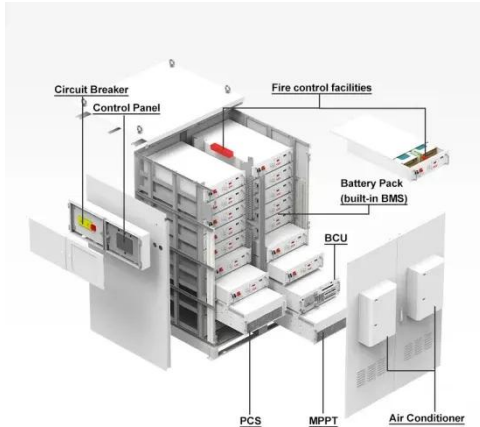
