The proposal to transform Bangladesh into an energy-efficient automobile center includes incentives such as a 10-year tax break for investments in energy-efficient vehicle assembly, the elimination of subsidies, and the establishment of charging stations. Given the Climate Change Mitigation Act, the government has been promoting the creation of framework conditions for the fast adoption of electric vehicles (EVs). Bangladesh intends to unconditionally reduce 3.39 million tonnes of carbon dioxide (CO₂) emissions from road transport by 2030, as stated. With a dozen incentives for manufacturers, importers and users, the government plans to mandate that at least 30 percent of all vehicles procured by government, semi-government, autonomous and corporations be electric by 2030. 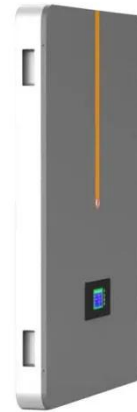

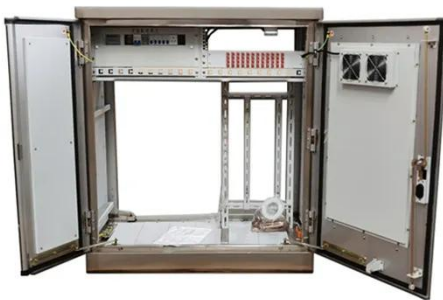
