The state-owned Radio Nacional de Angola (RNA) broadcasts on 5 stations. In 2001, toward the end of Angolan Civil War, the government began adopting regulations to liberalize the telecom industry. Under the country code +244, there were a total of 26.49 million connections in 2024. Among them were 26.41 million mobile phones, which corresponds to an average of 0.70 per person.
