It provides a buffer of time—ranging from a few minutes to several hours—so users can save data, maintain operations, or safely shut down equipment. Most UPS systems use sealed lead-acid.

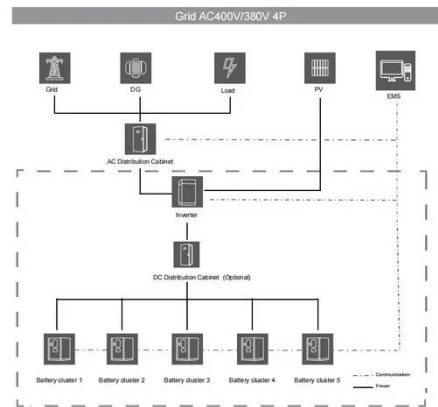

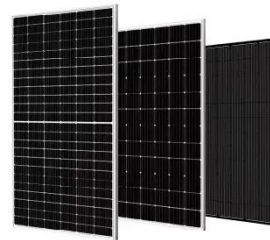

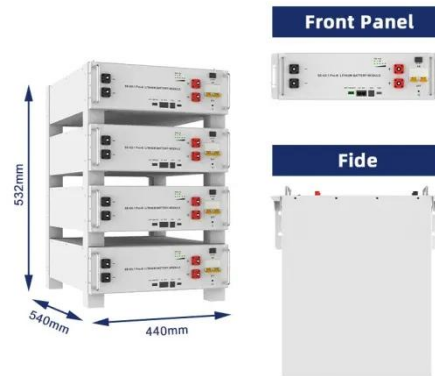
