

What to do if a communication base station owes electricity bills



Overview

First seek the assistance of your utility provider – they are required by law to assist you. If you are unable to get a satisfactory resolution from your utility provider, then contact the Department's Office of Consumer Services to file a complaint using any of the listed methods. The Department of Public Service assists consumers with service and billing issues regarding electric, natural gas, steam, landline telephone, cable tv and water utilities. Filing a lawsuit against a utility company can be complex, but it may be necessary if you have suffered damages due to their negligence or misconduct. Whether the issue. 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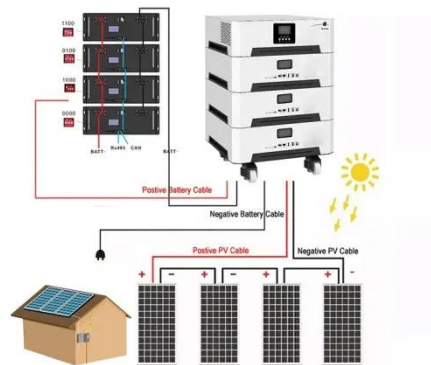
